DIRECTIONS TO VOTERS

1. Each elector will be issued with TWO ballot papers:-
 - (i) A **green** ballot paper for the election of the **Chairperson**, and
 - (ii) A **white** ballot paper for the election of **members** of the Executive Committee

2. Election of Chairperson (GREEN BALLOT PAPER).

Each elector shall vote for only **ONE** (1) candidate by putting a cross (x) opposite the name of the candidate of his/her choice.

3. Election of six (6) members of the Executive Committee (WHITE BALLOT PAPER).

Each elector shall vote for **six** (6) candidates by putting a cross (x) opposite the name of each candidate of his/her choice.

4. If an elector votes for more candidates or a lesser number of candidates than there are seats to be filled, or places any mark or writing on the ballot paper by which he/she could afterwards be identified, his/her vote/s will be void and will not be counted.

5. Each elector shall produce his/her **ORIGINAL LETTER OF CONVOCATION** and **National Identity Card** when applying for a ballot paper.
